**£39 per TGS member + £5 per non member**

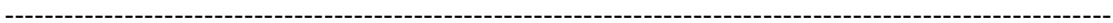
Eaton Hall gardens extend to 88 acres and have been developed over many years by prominent designers, most recently by Annabella Lennox-Boyd. The gardens have a wide variety of planting, including four formal colour-themed rose gardens and grand colour-themed herbaceous borders. The hot border was re-planted by 2022 and a stunning bedding scheme in the Dragon Garden is not to be missed. There is also a walled Kitchen Garden, a wildflower garden and the lake walk where you can take in fabulous views of the Hall and grounds.

Eaton Hall courtyard contains the Eaton Chapel with its splendid stained glass windows, the carriage museum and former stables as well as exhibitions on the Grosvenor family's history.

This is one of only three days during the year when Eaton Hall opens to the public. As tickets are limited and they have to be pre-booked it is advisable to book your place early.

Light refreshments will be available in the Courtyard Café.
