Normans Hall belongs to Martin and Pat McMillan. Designed by the owners over several years, the highlight of our mid-summer visit to Normans Hall will be its Italianate garden with roses, peonies, catmint and Verbena bonariensis making a spectacular display.

In addition there is a formal lavender garden, two greenhouses – one with tomatoes and spices and the other for flowering plants, an excellent vegetable patch, an orchard with wild flowers and bee hives (which make Normans Hall honey), soft fruit shrubs and a bug house.

There is a spectacular modern water feature and a walkway through the fields to a pond rich in wildlife. Tinkle Wood has a variety of Birch trees with very interesting bark together with many Vibernums.

A short talk about the garden will be given by Philip, the head gardener, during the visit.

Tea and cake will be served in a covered area in the Italian garden.
