They will deliver a practical and interactive course on all aspects of propagation aimed for those new to the practice and those wishing to develop their knowledge. There will be access to cutting material and seeds with the opportunity to take your work home.

Seeds – How to sow seeds. When to sow different kinds of seeds. Dealing with dormancy. Pricking out and caring for seedlings.

Cuttings – Learn how new plants grow from cuttings. How to take cuttings and when. Information about composts, timing and aftercare.

All participants are asked to bring their own snippers suitable for taking cuttings and to take responsibility for them.

The Course is delivered on behalf of the National Garden Scheme and all the proceeds of the day are donated to it.

The café at Tatton will be open all day for you to buy drinks and lunch.
