



**Three Anglesey Gardens**  
**By coach on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> August 2026**

**11am Plas Cadnant Gardens** On arrival at the gardens, we will be having light refreshments. The beautiful gardens of Plas Cadnant are situated at the side of the Menai Strait, hidden from view near to Menai Bridge. Former owners were related to the Tremayne family, famous for its Lost Gardens of Heligan. In 1996, the present owner bought the 200 acre Plas Cadnant Estate and work began on the restoration of the historic garden and grounds. Since then large parts of the gardens have undergone a spectacular transformation into a plantsman’s paradise and have been restored to their former glory. Extending to nearly ten acres, the garden has three distinct areas: The large 'Walled Garden', The 'Valley Garden' with its waterfalls and The 'Upper Woodland Garden'.

**For lunch you can visit the garden’s tea room or bring a picnic. We will leave here at 1.30 pm.**

**2.00pm Llwyn Onn and The Old School Gardens at Penmon**

We will split into two groups here with a guided tour around the gardens should you wish. Llwyn Onn features native deciduous woodland, regeneratively managed, together with herbaceous borders and a small wildlife pond. Paul also produces Bio Char in a special kiln and runs research experiments to encourage wildflower species in previously managed pastureland. The Old School garden has been created on the rocky remains of quarried stone. Free draining, but sheltered from the wind, the garden is full of semi tender plants; roses, agapanthus, echiums, salvias, abutilons. Some plants for sale, subject to availability.

**Refreshments will be served at Llwyn Onn before we embark on our journey home at 4.30 pm.**

A general note regarding accessibility. Anglesey is a rocky outcrop in the sea and the gardens reflect the hilly terrain. There are sloping paths, steep in parts, and steps to navigate. Should limited mobility restrict visiting some parts of the gardens, the scenery is still beautiful and there are plenty of places simply to sit and enjoy the views of the Menai Strait and mountains of Eryri / Snowdonia. Walking boots and poles/sticks recommended. Toilets are available at all the gardens.
